Principles of Champions of champion calculation:

Rewards the team with the best performance across all 4 disciplines. Wakeboarding as an individual event is given a weighting of 1/3 as opposed to 1/4 to encourage wakeboarding only oriented teams to still have a crack at 3 event and to reflect that wakeboarding is a stand alone event with plenty of popularity rather than just a 4th add-on to the waterskiing.
